Business Diploma

(4 semesters, non co-op)

In this **diploma program**, students acquire a foundational knowledge of the basics of business, with a focus on managing people and processes. Courses in economics, accounting, marketing, and human resources lay the groundwork for future careers. Graduates can enter the workforce or continue studies into degree and post-graduate diploma programs.

Entry Requirements: ILAC Pathway 3.2, or IELTS 6.0 with no band less than 5.5 (SDS program – IELTS score 6.0, no band less than 6.0) * + Grade 11 or 12 Math

Start Dates: Fall, Winter, Summer

Career Outcomes: Graduates from this program will have career opportunities as management trainee/manager, sales/sales manager, personnel officer/manager at finance, insurance companies, computer firms, producers of consumer and industrial products, wholesalers, retailers, private companies and non-profits.

Computer Programming

(4 semesters, with co-op)

In this **diploma program**, students focus on computer programming, web development, and designing data-driven systems. Students learn how to write code in a variety of programming languages such as Arduino, ASP.NET, C#, Java, JavaScript, HTML/CSS, PHP and Swift.

Entry Requirements: ILAC Pathway 3.2, or IELTS 6.0 with no band less than 5.5 (SDS program – IELTS score 6.0, no band less than 6.0) * + OSSD or equivalent with: Grade 12 English (C or U) & any Grade 12 Mathematics (C or U)

Start Dates: Fall, Winter, Summer

Career Outcomes: Graduates from this program are well suited to fulfill a wide-range of entry-level roles related to software development to analyze, design, enhance, and maintain software applications, on a variety of platforms including desktop, mobile, web, and mainframe systems.





Computer Systems Technician - Networking

(4 semesters, with co-op)

In this **diploma program**, students focus on networking, operating systems, system administration, cloud computing, and security related to new computer networks and the maintenance of existing computer networks. Students acquire professional and entrepreneurial skills for industry and self-employment, as well as practical experience through participation in a co-op work term.

Entry Requirements: ILAC Pathway 3.2, or IELTS 6.0 with no band less than 5.5 (SDS program – IELTS score 6.0, no band less than 6.0) * + OSSD or equivalent with: Grade 12 English (C or U) & any Grade 12 Mathematics (C or U)

Start Dates: Fall, Winter, Summer Career Outcomes: Graduates can choose to work independently or as a member of a team to support the development, implementation, and maintenance of computer systems and networks.

Office Administration -Health Services

(4 semesters)

In this **diploma program**, students acquire the knowledge and specialized skills required to successfully perform in the administrative health field. Students learn medical document production, medical terminology, transcription, human anatomy, medical ethics, and develop skills in workplace communication and patient relations.

Entry Requirements: ILAC Pathway 3.2, or IELTS 6.0 with no band less than 5.5 (SDS program – IELTS score 6.0, no band less than 6.0) * + OSSD or equivalent with: Grade 12 English (C or U)

Start Dates: Fall, Winter, Summer Career Outcomes: Graduates from this program may find employment in medical practitioners' offices, long-term care facilities, and hospitals. They may also find careers opportunities within the pharmaceutical industry and other areas of health services.

Human Resources Management

(2 semesters, with co-op)

This **graduate certificate** program provides human resources management training to candidates who seek skills to manage workplace organizations. Graduates from the program will be ready to perform all human resources functions within the business environment.

Entry Requirements: ILAC Pathway 3.2 or IELTS 6.5 with no band less than 6.0 (same for SDS program) * + Post-secondary diploma or degree, or equivalent; three years of postsecondary education is desirable.

Start Dates: Fall, Winter, Summer

Career Outcomes: Graduates from this program can find career opportunities in all sectors of the economy because every organization, whether private or not-for-profit, has a human resources function.



Business Management

(2 semesters)

This **graduate certificate** program is designed to develop the skills in researching, analyzing, and managing many aspects of business. Business skills obtained in this program will enhance graduate employability and the individual's long-term opportunities for advancement.

Entry Requirements: ILAC Pathway 3.2 or IELTS 6.5 with no band less than 6.0 (same for SDS program) * + Post-secondary diploma or degree, or equivalent; education or experience in a business setting is desirable.

Start Dates: Fall, Winter, Summer **Career Outcomes:** Graduates can work in a broad range of domestic and international employment settings, including manufacturers, banks, international business consulting firms,

and other small and large businesses.

Career Outcomes: Graduates of this program may be prepared to work in a variety of businessfocused environments and middlemanagement roles, including: account executives, brand managers, sales and marketing managers.

Global Business Management

(4 semesters)

Entry Requirements: ILAC Pathway 3.2 or IELTS 6.5 with no band less than 6.0 (same for SDS program) * + Post-secondary diploma or degree, or equivalent; education or experience in a business setting is desirable.

Start Dates: Fall, Winter, Summer

Career Outcomes: Graduates of this program are prepared for entry-level management positions in research, marketing, sales, project management, information management, supply chain, and finance.





Project Management

(2 semesters)

This graduate certificate program provides management training to candidates who require project management skills. The program covers technical, leadership, business, and strategic management subjects with an emphasis on understanding and managing change as applied to project management.

Entry Requirements: ILAC Pathway 3.2 or IELTS 6.5 with no band less than 6.0 (same for SDS program) * + Post-secondary diploma or degree, or equivalent; education or experience in a business setting is desirable.

Start Dates: Fall, Winter, Summer

Career Outcomes: Graduates of this program can work as supervisor, Manager, Program/Project Manager, Team Lead, other supervisory or middle management positions in a variety of disciplines including business, service industries, and so on.
