- ILAC Pathway 3.2 or IELTS 6.5 with no band less than 6.0 (same for SDS program)*
 * Other language proficiency tests accepted include Duolingo (until Dec. 31, 2022), TOEFL, CAE and TOEIC

Students gain global supply chain competencies by examining the connections between strategic objectives, stakeholder expectations, and supply chain design, functions, processes, and roles.

Graduates of this program are prepared to work in a broad range of domestic and international employment settings within the supply chain. Career options include positions in manufacturing, operations, procurement, planning, inventory management, logistics, transportation, materials handling, warehousing, importing and exporting, freight forwarding, thirdand fourth-party logistics providers, and customer service.
