2. Toronto and GTA

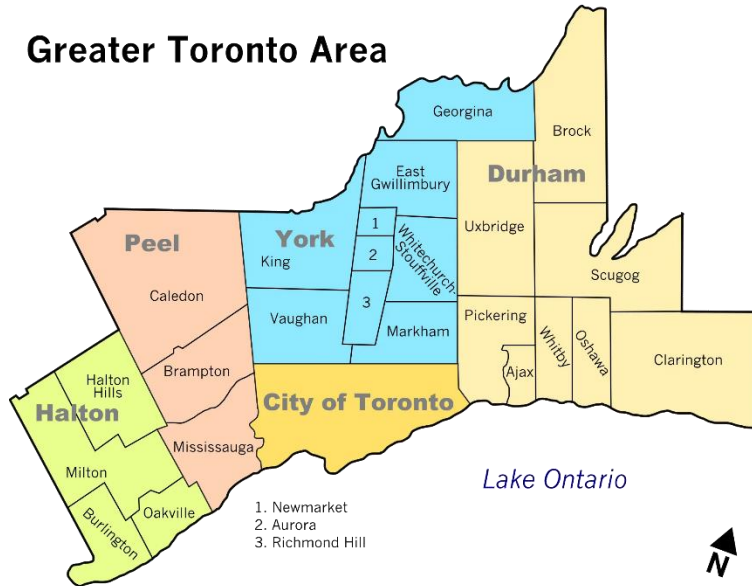

The Greater Toronto Area, commonly referred to as the GTA, includes the City of Toronto and the regional municipalities of Durham, Halton, Peel, and York. In total, the region contains 25 urban, suburban, and rural municipalities. According to the latest census data from 2021 from Statistics Canada, the population of this area is 6,711,985.

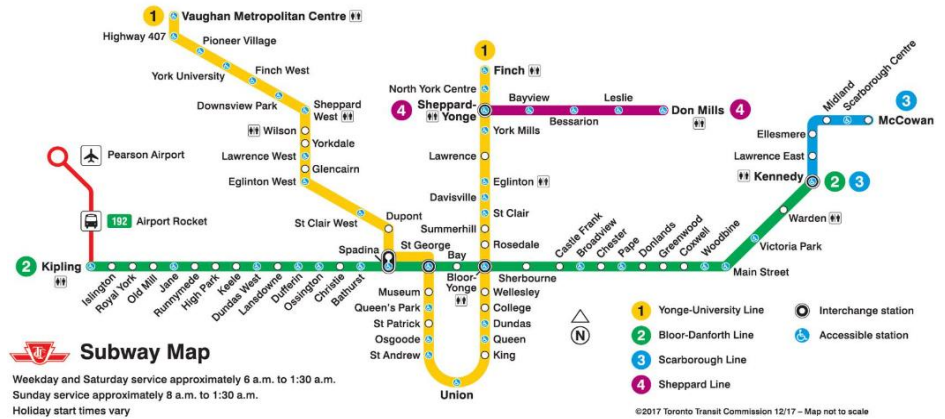
1. TTC (Public Toronto Transit)
